Eligibility: Open to all artists

- All work must be original, executed exclusively by the artist and completed within the last 2 years (except children's division). No work exhibited in past Mayor's Art Shows. No prints or giclees (except digital art/photography) will be accepted.

- **Paintings, photos and any artwork to be hung must be framed and have secure wire on back ready for hanging. (No clip frames)**

- **Size limit:** Outside dimensions maximum 40" length or width including frame. **Three dimensional art** limited to 50 pounds and 40" length or width. The combined dimensions of works consisting of multi pieces (example, diptych (2) or triptych (3)), must meet size and weight limits (including space between pieces).

- **Note:** Mayor's Art Show has the right to refuse any art that does not meet stated specifications, is violent, and/or is controversial. Committee may refuse any art work that is considered obscene, offensive, or is otherwise deemed inappropriate. A copy of the EAC policy on the display of art is available upon request. **No nudes will be accepted.**

No early entries will be accepted.

Artists **must** exhibit accepted art pieces October 2nd through October 29th, 2010.

Return of Work

All art pieces must be picked up on Saturday, October 30, 2010 between 11 am- 4pm, or it will be stored at artist's expense at a charge of \$5.00 per day. Emerald Art Center will not be held responsible for any damage to items not picked up by that date. Works left past 30 days will be considered abandoned and will be disposed of accordingly.

Framing

Photos, Paintings, and/or any work to be hung must be framed and have secure wires in place and ready to hang. (No clip frames) Gallery wrap canvases with appropriate wire and no visible staples will be accepted. Work not conforming to regulations will not be accepted.

Sales

A commission of 30% for EEAA members; 40% for Non-Members will be collected on sales.

All adult art pieces must be for sale.

Liability

EEAA will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any work submitted to this exhibition. The City of Springfield, owners of the property, Emerald Empire Art Association, or directors will be held harmless of damage or loss of artwork while on the premises. Artists will enter work at their own risk. It is suggested that artists carry their own insurance. Submitting a work to this exhibition shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist to the conditions set forth herein.
